# What is this product?

# Investment strategy

The fund is actively managed.

- A proprietary tool called 'SmartGARP' is used as the foundation of the investment process. It screens the financial characteristics of companies by identifying those that are growing faster than the market but are trading on lower valuations than the market.
- The manager selects companies that in aggregate have good 'SmartGARP' characteristics. This tends to mean that the portfolio contains stocks that have lower valuations than the market average, upgrades to profit forecasts, and are under-owned by the investment community, while at the same time benefiting from helpful trends in the wider economy.

#### Benchmarks

MSCI EM (Emerging Markets) NR

A widely-used indicator of the performance of emerging markets stock markets, in which the fund invests. It acts as a 'comparator benchmark' against which the fund's performance can be compared. Management of the fund is not restricted by this benchmark.

• IA Global Emerging Markets NR

A group of other asset managers' funds that invest in similar asset types as this fund, collated by the Investment Association. It acts as a 'comparator benchmark' against which the fund's performance can be compared. Management of the fund is not restricted by this benchmark.

#### Intended retail investor

This product is intended for investors who are willing to invest for a long term and who plan to stay invested for at least 5 years. Investors should be prepared to take on a relatively high level of risk of loss to their original capital in order to get a higher potential return.
