## WHAT IS THIS PRODUCT?

Type: This product is a share of an investment company qualifying as an undertaking for collective investment in transferable securities

(UCITS).

Term: This product has no maturity date. However, the Board of Directors may decide to close the product under certain circumstances.

Objectives: The Fund seeks to achieve capital appreciation and income generation by investing primarily in fixed income securities issued by

issuers located globally. The Fund is an actively managed UCITS where the manager has discretion over the composition of its portfolio, subject to the stated investment objectives and policy. To achieve its investment objective, the Fund will primarily invest in fixed income securities issued by issuers which are located globally, focusing primarily on issuers located in Canada, the United States, Mexico, Brazil, South Africa, Germany, Italy, France, the United Kingdom, Sweden, the People's Republic of China ("PRC"), Japan, South Korea, Australia, Oman, Saudi Arabia and other Asian emerging markets. Issuers of such securities may include, but are not limited to, governments, quasi government organisations, public or local authorities, state owned organisations,

banks and financial institutions, private enterprises and corporations.

The Fund launched on 21 November 2019. The Share Class launched on 21 November 2019.

The currency of the Fund is USD, the currency of this product is USD.

Distribution Policy: No dividends will be paid, declared or distributed. The gross income and net realised and unrealised capital

gains will be accumulated and re-invested.

WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?

#### Risk indicator





The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 5 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

#### WHAT ARE THE COSTS?

#### Cost over time

The tables below show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. #### HOW LONG SHOULD I HOLD IT AND CAN I TAKE MY MONEY OUT EARLY?
