What is this product?

Type:

This product is a UCITS Fund [authorised in Luxembourg and regulated by the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier].

Term:

This product is not subject to any fixed term.

Objectives:

The Fund aims to grow the value of your investment over the long term and aims for a better sustainability profile when compared to relevant broad market indices.

The Fund is actively managed and will invest globally, in a diversified range of asset classes via other investment funds, company shares, government and corporate bonds. The Fund may invest a significant portion, above 50% of its net assets, in other investment funds. The assets of these investment funds will be varied and may include company shares, bonds issued by companies and governments (which are similar to loans that pay a fixed or variable rate of interest), cash and deposits, commodities (wheat, coffee, gold etc.) and other investments. Assets of these other funds will be from around the world and valued in different currencies.

The Fund will consider any indirect investments through other investment funds, that are classified as Article 8 or Article 9 under the EU Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation (SFDR) are compliant with its sustainability criteria. The sustainability profile of direct investments in company shares (including investment trusts) or any indirect investments in investment funds that are not classified as Article 8 or Article 9 funds will be assessed using third party data.

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The Fund will not knowingly hold securities issued by any company whose core business activity includes the production of tobacco, controversial weapons or coal. Investments in government bonds, alternative strategies and investment funds investing in commodities, will not be assessed against the sustainability criteria.

The Fund may invest indirectly in the following higher risk investments:

- up to 20% of its Net Asset Value in asset-backed or mortgage backed securities
- up to 20% of its Net Asset Value in Contingent Convertible Bonds
- · Up to 20% of its Net Asset Value in aggregate providing exposure to alternative strategies and commodities via collective investment schemes or listed close ended funds

Intended Retail Investor:

The Fund is offered to investors who may have basic or no knowledge and experience of investing in financial markets and also experienced investors. The Fund is intended for long-term investment, in line with the recommended holding period or longer. Investors should understand the risks involved, including the risk of losing capital invested and must evaluate the Fund's objective and risks in terms of whether they are consistent with their own investment goals and risk tolerances.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

The Management Company, as the manufacturer of this product has no obligation to pay out since the product design does not contemplate any such payment being made. However, investors may suffer loss if the Fund or the depositary is unable to pay out. There is no compensation or guarantee scheme in place which may offset, all or any, of this loss.

What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

Costs over Time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, how long you hold the product and how well the product does. We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0% annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period:

6 Years

This product has no required minimum holding period but is designed for long-term investment. Since the value of investments can rise and fall over differing time periods, you should have an investment horizon of at least 6 years when buying an investment of this type.

The minimum recommended holding period is therefore 6 years. You can request to take out some or all of your money at any time. You can typically request to buy or sell shares in the Fund on any business day (as set out in the Fund's prospectus).
