What is the product?

Type: Undertaking for Collective Investment in Transferable Securities (UCITS) under European Directive 2009/65/EC. An investment company with variable capital (société d'investissement à capital variable or "SICAV") under Luxembourg law.

Term: This product is not subject to any fixed term.

Objectives:

The sub-fund's objective is to seek regular, above-average income. Under normal circumstances, the sub-fund invests mainly in bonds and bond market instruments that meet strict ethical and financial criteria.

The sub-fund may also invest in other securities permitted by UCITS regulations. The sub-fund may use investment techniques and derivatives for efficient portfolio management (including hedging). The sub-fund is managed at the fund manager's discretion without reference to any benchmark. The manager uses its own analysis to identify those individual bonds that can offer the best overall combination of price, risk, income and also meet established ethical standards

Intended Retail Investor: This product targets Retail and Professional investors and as a minimum requirement, is suited to a first time investor with a basic knowledge of investments. This product targets investors who intend to invest their money for a minimum period of 5 years. Rathbones defines the minimum recommended holding period of 5 years as Long Term. This product is appropriate for investors who have a risk appetite compatible with the SRI of the product as defined in the Prospectus. This product may be distributed as follows: on an execution only basis without a suitability assessment; with investment advice; or, as a component of a managed portfolio.

The depositary is HSBC Continental Europe, Luxembourg. Further information regarding the Fund, all available Sub-Funds and share classes, including copies of the prospectus, annual and half yearly report and accounts, can be obtained free of charge (in English and other required languages) from the registered office of the Company, 4, rue Peternelchen, L-2370, Howald, Grand Duchy of Luxembourg.

Be aware of currency risk. You may receive payments in a different currency than the Sub-Fund's base currency, so the final return you get may depend on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator above.

The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for a minimum of 5 Years. You may not be able to sell your product easily or may have to sell at a price that significantly impacts on how much you get back.

We have classified this product as class 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class. This rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level, and poor market conditions are unlikely to impact the capacity of the fund to pay you.
